Lead line - Open to riders 7 years of age and under as of 12/1/15. Riders may not cross enter into any class where they would be asked to trot.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation – Open to riders 10 years and under as of 12/1/15. Riders may not cross enter into any classes where they would be asked to canter or jump.

Short Stirrup Hunter -Open to riders 12 and under as of 12/01/15. Riders can not cross over into any classes over 18” and mounts may not cross into any other division but Pleasure. (VHSA)

Children’s Pony Hunter- Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Fences 2’

Pleasure Pony – Open to ponies ridden by Juniors. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going. (VHSA)

Pony Hunter – Open to ponies ridden by Juniors. The division will be split to small/medium and large ponies if entries warrant. Fences: Small 2’0”, Medium 2’3”, Large 2’6”. (VHSA)

VHSA Pony Equitation – Open to ponies ridden by Juniors. Fences: Small 2’0”, Medium 2’3”, Large 2’6” or 2’9”. The judge may select at least ¼ of the class to show at the walk/trot/canter and to perform additional tests at the judge’s discretion.

Equitation on the Flat – Open to juniors on horses or ponies, and adult amateurs on horses or ponies not entered in a pony division. To be shown at walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. Test 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. May be split: Juniors (14 and under), Juniors (15-17), and Adults, if entries warrant. (VHSA)

Pleasure Horse – Open to any horse. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going. May be split: Junior and Adult, if entries warrant. TIP TB Must have TIP number to earn rewards in TIP Program. (VHSA)

Low/TIP Hunter –Open to all horses or ponies. No restrictions on riders. TIP TB Must have TIP number to earn rewards in TIP Program. Fences: 2’0”, 2’6”

Green Hunter – Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2’6” or higher as of 12/1/15. Fences: 2’6”. May be split if entries warrant. (VHSA)

Green Pony Hunter – Open to ponies in their first year of showing at regulation heights as of 12/1/15 ridden by Juniors. Fences: Small 2’0”, Medium 2’3”, Large 2’6”. May be split if entries warrant. (VHSA)

Children’s/Adult Amateur Hunter – Open to horses ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateurs. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences: 2’6” or 3’0”. May be split if entries warrant.

Thoroughbred Hunter-The VHSA Associate Thoroughbred Hunter Division is limited to horses who are registered with or are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. In order to accrue VHSA Associate points the height for this division shall be no lower than 2’6". **Open to Thoroughbred horses only.** TIP TB Must have TIP number to earn TIP rewards.

VHSA Children’s/Adult Amateur Equitation – Open to horses ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateurs. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences: 2’6” or 3’0”. The judge may select at least ¼ of the class to show at the walk/trot/canter and to perform additional tests at the judge’s discretion. May be split if entries warrant.

Year-end awards in each division to be presented at the October 1st final Fox Pointe Farm Hunter Series Show. Fox Pointe Farm as also offering a “Top Trainer Award” of \$100 prize money to the trainer who brings the most students/horses to the show series. This award will also be presented October 1st. *Trainer must register (free) *

TIP Program

The Jockey Club T.I.P. Green OTTB High Point Award will be given to the highest placing Thoroughbred at the competition (regardless of discipline/division) that raced within the past two years.

The Jockey Club T.I.P. Young Rider High Point Award will be given to the Thoroughbred/rider combination accumulating the most points where the rider is 18 years old or younger.

The Jockey Club T.I.P. High Point Thoroughbred Award will be given to the highest placing Thoroughbred at the competition (regardless of discipline/division).

All Hunter classes will be judged on performance; including way of going, jumping style and soundness. Manners and suitability will be emphasized in Pony, Children’s and Adult Amateur Hunter classes.

All Equitation classes will be judged on hands, seat, guidance, and control.

You may join or renew your VHSA Memberships at the Secretary Stand. Please be prepared to pay with a check. Cash will not be accepted.

Show Rules

ASTM/SEI certified helmets must be worn by ALL RIDERS when mounted. Proper attire is required. Jackets may be excused by the judge.

1. Class Specification – Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and regulations of the current VHSA rule book, will be conducted and judged accordingly. The judge's decision is always final.
2. All exhibitors must be checked in at the in gate when their class is called.
3. Stall \$25/day
4. Entries will not be accepted without the release on the entry form signed.
5. All ages are as of December 1, 2016.
6. All horses/ponies on show grounds must present a negative coggins test taken within one year for each entry. Please bring a copy to the show secretary.
7. Entries must leave a blank check with the show secretary upon registering.
8. \$50.00 will be charged for returned checks.
9. Points will be counted 10,6,4,2,1,.5, Champion 10, Reserve Champion 6. Point system is subject to change per VHSA rule change.
10. Show management reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel and/or combine classes if necessary.
11. Exhibitors show at their own risk.
12. Lunging is permitted only in the schooling ring.
13. Schooling will be allowed in the ring the morning of the show and at designated times. Show management reserves the right to split or to terminate schooling.
14. Food will be available on the grounds.
15. Limited day stalls are available for \$25.00 Please call ahead to reserve.
16. Fox Pointe Farm LLC, any officials, and employees related to the foundation, and its board of directors, will not be held responsible for any
17. Accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, groom, property, or animal at the show.
